1 Present/apols	Present: Phil Shaw (V. Chair), Claire Rushton, Tom Wall, Tim Bennett (Treas), Richard Belk (Secy). Apologies from: George Wharton and Duncan Orme.	Information
2 Minutes of May 20 th meeting & matters arising not already on agenda	Minutes were circulated before meeting and accepted as accurate record of business. It was noted that British Cycling had yet to respond to Tim's enquiry about NW coaching.	ACTION: Tim to chase BC for information on NW training.
3 Promotional flier designed by Andrew Tanner to publicise KVRC	Tom had printed off examples of Andrew's design and all were happy with it. Tom had already got a price of £28 for 200 from Kent Valley Colour Printers.	ACTION: Tom to place initial order for 200 fliers with printers and committee to get them out to shops & other outlets.
4 Financial Update, membership count and club memorial donation or effort after deaths Louise Kelly and Chris Stirling.	Tim reported that overall money situation was unchanged though £635 and £347 had been sent to Cancer Care and NW Air Ambulance respectively from Midsummer 10 and Edwin Howson Memorial 25. Richard said we were now up to around 70 members when outstanding payments and membership forms came in. He had ordered chips and bread buns for 25 after champs 25 (£100) and 12 new hi-viz marshalling bibs with our club name on (£118 with postage). Claire felt club should do something to mark deaths of Louise and Chris, even if only a donation to MIND.	ACTION: 1) post charity outcomes from midsummer weekend tts on FB and officially record thanks to Tim and Richard Bryan for organising them. 2) Information re spending and membership count. 3) Claire to speak to Sadie McKeand re COLT's response to Louise's death, and Richard to speak to Chris Dixon re that of Chris Stirling. Both to report back.
5 Awards buffet update	Tom said Factory Tap could do a buffet for 50 @ £10 per head upstairs in the pub from 3pm to 6pm with no room charge. October 17 th was favoured date and Tom suggested we did Freewheel contest that morning as part of a social clubrun, then gather in afternoon.	ACTION: agreed that Tom check on the date, and if available, go for Oct 17 th and combine it with Freewheel in the morning.
6 Westmorland Tankard	RB explained why BC cancelled the event on original date. Duncan had messaged him to say it was not really do-able to re-run it on Bob Swailes date, and a check showed that there were not races planned for last two weeks of September. Chance of putting on a handicap road race now seemed unlikely after this summer's accredited marshalling crisis and cancellation of so many events.	ACTION: Agreed we try to re-organise Tankard road race for end of September if George was okay with that.
7 Highways Agency A590 consulation	Richard attended and reported that HA had been studying accident and traffic stats and had identified several right-turn issues which it felt could be resolved with barriered-off central reservation openings and a roundabout at Gilpin Bridge to make problem turns much safer left-handers. In addition, CCC was keen to encourage traffic from A591 to approach central Lakes via Newby Bridge and Lyth Valley too. Time-trialling disquiet revolved around using A590 on Cartmel Races days.	Information – Richard had also reported back to CTT North and agreement had been reached to try to avoid Cartmel Races days for open events next season.
