2 Minutes & matters arising.	Minutes circulated before meeting and accepted. (1) Re fitting day rides into 2020 events calendar, Tom proposed June 28 th and July 26 th (Solway). (2) Richard said Peter Knott's son Ian was keen to present trophy provided by NLTTA in memory of his dad at our new July SpoCo 15 time trial.	Information
3 Financial update	Tim reported little change with a balance of around £4,500. However, cheques for April's Wild Boar Fell Spoco time trial were not posted out and new ones were now being provided, making him wonder if it was time to make all KVRC open time trials charity events. No-one had complained and no-one rode just to win £10-£15 cheques anyway.	ACTION: (1) Club donate £100 each to MIND and Greanpeace in memory of Christ Stirling and Louise Kelly. (2) We make all our open time trials charity events in 2021. (3) Club general bank account details be added to membership forms to make annual payments simpler.
4 Kit: review current supplier, audit current club stock and discuss having "Kent Valley Road Club Kendal" on future garments	Richard explained that Claire felt Tactic kit, while good, was on the expensive side and ordering windows were restrictive for anyone new who wanted to buy club clothing. Claire also wanted to offer a detailed list of existing Giordana stock and remaining anniversary jerseys on website. The suggestion of having "Kendal" in club name had come from Paul Latham who thought KVRC alone was too misleading. Many people thought we were a Kentish club.
